YOU ARE REQUIRED BY STATUTE TO COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING SEX OFFENDER REQUIREMENTS

****REGISTRANT'S INITIALS SIGNIFY UNDERSTANDING OF EACH REQUIREMENT****

As a sex offender you shall report to the department as follows:

INITIAL IN EACH BOX

1. As part of planning for the release of a sex offender from a correctional facility to the community upon completion of the offender's maximum sentence, the Department of Corrections shall notify the offender of his or her obligation to report to the Department to register as a sex offender in compliance with T.13 V.S.A. §5407 prior to the offender's scheduled release date. The Department of Corrections shall assist the offender with registration as a sex offender and advise the offender that failure to register with the Department prior to release is a crime subject to T.13 V.S.A §5409.

I understand this requirement (INITIAL HERE)

2. If convicted of a registry offense in another state, within 10 days after either establishing residence in this state or crossing into this state for purposes of employment, carrying on a vocation, or being a student, the sex offender shall provide the information listed in T.13 §5403(a);

I understand this requirement (INITIAL HERE)

3. Annually within 10 days after the registrant's birthday, or if a person is determined to be a sexually violent predator, that person shall report to the department every 90 days (T.13 V.S.A. §5407(a)(2));

I understand this requirement (INITIAL HERE)

4. Within three days after any change of address, or if a person is designated as a high-risk sex offender pursuant to section 5411b of this title, that person shall report to the department within 36 hours, and shall report whether a child under the age of 18 resides at such address (T.13 V.S.A. 5407(a)(3));

I understand this requirement (INITIAL HERE)

5. Within three days after the registrant enrolls in or separates from any postsecondary educational institution (T.13 V.S.A. §5407(a)(4));

I understand this requirement (INITIAL HERE)

6. Within three days after any change in place of employment (T.13 V.S.A. § 5407(a)(5));

I understand this requirement (INITIAL HERE)

7. Within three days of any name change (T.13 V.S.A. 5407(a)(6));

I understand this requirement (INITIAL HERE)

8. Within three days of a child under the age of 18 moving into the residence of the registrant (T.13 V.S.A. § 5407(a)(7));

I understand this requirement (INITIAL HERE)

9. If a sex offender changes residence to another state, or crosses into another state for purposes of employment, carrying on a vocation, or being a student, the sex offender shall notify the department of the new address and shall also register with the designated law enforcement agency in the new state not later than three days after establishing residence in the new state, if the new state has a registration requirement (T.13 V.S.A. § 5407(b));

I understand this requirement (INITIAL HERE)

10. Sex offender registration periods are either 10 years or lifetime (T.13 V.S.A. §5407(e) & T.13 V.S.A. §5407 (f));

I understand this requirement (INITIAL HERE)

11. A registrant who has no permanent address shall report to the department to notify it as to his or her temporary residence. Temporary residence, for purposes of this section, need not include an actual dwelling or numbered street address, but shall identify a specific location. A registrant shall not be required to check in daily if he or she makes acceptable other arrangements with the department to keep his or her information current (T.13 V.S.A. §5407 (h));

I understand this requirement (INITIAL HERE)

12. Failure to comply with any of the requirements indicated above is grounds for an arrest warrant to be issued for you. If you are convicted of failing to comply with the law you could be imprisoned for not more than two years and/or fined not more than \$1000. A second or subsequent offense could result in a sentence of imprisonment of not more than 3 years and/or a fine of not more than \$5000 (T.13 V.S.A. §5409).
